Telephones/Contact Information

- Do not call OotM after Wednesday May 28th; the office will have moved onto campus.
- Pay phones are available in some buildings on campus.
- We suggest after checking in to housing, participants call home to give family members the building name, room number and their residence hall hospitality desk phone number, where they may leave a message.
- To call off campus from any on-campus phone, participants will need to call collect or use a calling card. Most residence hall rooms do not have telephones.

Emergency Contact Number

In the event it is necessary to contact a participant residing on campus, parents and other family members can locate participants by calling 301.314.OMER (6637). This line will be answered 24 hours a day beginning noon, Friday, May 30. In the event of a life-threatening emergency, always call University Police at 301.405.3333 (or 911 from any campus phone).

Special Note About Using Cell Phones During Emergencies

If you dial 911 from your cell phone while on campus, you will be directed to Prince George's County Police, not the University of Maryland police. If you must use your cell phone during an on campus emergency, please call University Police at 301.405.3333. Otherwise, dial 911 on any campus landline phone.

Do not call 911 from a cell phone if trapped in an elevator. Please use the phone in the elevator, call the police at 301.405.3333, your residence hall hospitality desk, or 301.314.OMER (6637).
